The 13<sup>th</sup> AGM and Dinner of The 20-Ghost Club Limited, incorporating the 67<sup>th</sup> AGM of The 20-Ghost Club will be held at Cutlers' Hall, 4 Warwick Lane, London EC4M 7BR on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2017

The Cutlers' Company is one of the oldest livery companies in the City, ranked number 18 in the order of precedence in the City's 110 livery companies. The Company has had a hall in the City of London since the 13<sup>th</sup> century. The present hall dates from 1888. The building survived the Blitz although the north wall was destroyed and rebuilt after the War. Outside the Hall on the right of the entrance is a finely carved terracotta frieze by the Sheffield sculptor Benjamin Creswick. Pictured above, the frieze shows cutlers working at their craft. Inside there is an attractive stained glass window showing Henry V granting the original Charter to the Company in 1416. The Livery Hall is also pictured above.

Drinks will be served in the Dining Hall at 18.30 followed by the AGM at 19.00 in the Court Room. The dinner will start at 20.00 and will conclude with the award of trophies. We expect to finish by 22.45. Dress is Black Tie.

With kind permission of the Recorder of the City of London, His Honour Judge Nicholas Hilliard QC, and the two Sheriffs of the City of London, Alderman William Russell and Alderman Peter Estlin, those who are interested in viewing the Central Criminal Court (The Old Bailey) will be welcomed by His Honour Judge Richard Hone QC at 17.15 at the Old Bailey (Entrance in Warwick Square, off Warwick Lane, London EC4M 7BP), which is adjacent to Cutlers' Hall.
