Dutch Discovery Tour

The eastern part of the Netherlands has kept its traditional historical look with a mixture of natural and cultural elements. This region is perfect for driving and sight-seeing. This region (de Achterhoek) flourished in the 16th century with the founding of the well-known Hanseatic cities of Deventer, Zutphen and Doesburg.

The Tour starts on Monday the 11th of September at Putten, where we come together at the country house hotel 'de Vanenburg'. For those coming from the UK, Putten is 130 kms from Hook of Holland. We will welcome all participants with a nice cup of tea. In the evening you will enjoy a lovely dinner during which we will give you all the details of the following day's tour. In the morning of Tuesday the 12th we leave for Paleis het Loo at Apeldoorn. This former royal palace was built in 1689 and has impressive formal French gardens. We will be able to visit the gardens and the outside of the palace and have coffee in the former stables (now a brasserie). From here we leave in the direction of Deventer. On the way we will have a lunch. Deventer is one of the oldest cities of the Netherlands and received its city rights in 1123. We take some time to walk around and to soak up the atmosphere of this Hanseatic city. From there we take a lovely drive to our next evening stop, the Landgoed Hotel Ehzerwold in country setting at Almen, where we will stay two nights. This day we drive around 100 kms.

On Wednesday the 13th of September we will head for the northern part of the Achterhoek. This is a day for visiting small villages and for driving on beautiful country roads. There are plenty of opportunities to enjoy a cup of coffee on the way. We will drive over the Holterberg and visit Kasteel Twickel (16th century), where we have lunch. In the afternoon we will visit a few historical estates, where you have the possibility to enjoy their gardens. We will stay a second night at the Landgoed Hotel Ehzerwold at Almen. The total distance will be 150 kms.

On Thursday the 14th we start with a visit to the museum, Kasteel Ruurlo. From here we will discover the southern part of the Achterhoek. We will have lunch at the museum inn Erve Kots.. After lunch we will visit the old Hanseatic city of Doesberg and the smallest city of The Netherland, Bronkhorst.

After that we will cross the river IJssel by ferry. This river was very important for the prosperous development of the Hanseatic cities. We end our day at the Hotel Kasteel Engelenburg, a luxury hotel, where we have our final dinner. The total distance is about 120 kms.
