



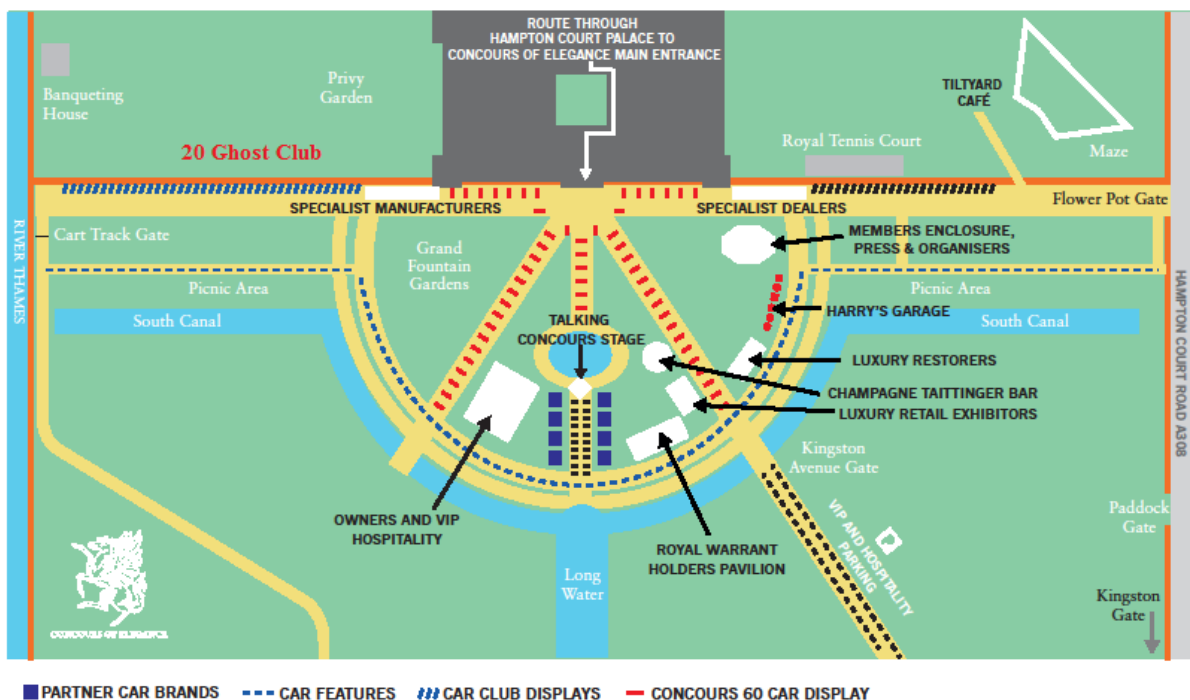
Hampton Court Weekend, Concours of Excellence

31 August - 2 September 2017



The Concours of Elegance is an annual event run by Thorough Events UK which brings together a selection of 60 of the rarest cars from around the world, typically drawn in equal proportions from the UK, the US and The Rest of the World. The event has been held in marvellous locations since 2012, Windsor Castle, St James Palace in London, Holyrood house in Edinburgh and this year it will be at Hampton Court. A panel of collectors and experts choose the cars, covering all marques of all ages, many of which will never have been seen before in the UK. Several 20 Ghost Club members with rare or exotic cars have been invited to display in the past. In addition, on each of the three days there are special events in which other car clubs are invited to attend.

This year, they have invited up to twenty members of the 20 Ghost Club to show their cars as part of the clubs display on Friday 1st of September which is called the Owners Day. The event is at Hampton Court and we have been allocated a prime location at the rear of the Palace between the Privy Garden and the Grand Fountain Gardens.

Two of our best/most original member's cars will be chosen by us to compete for the Club Trophy. 40 cars will be competing for this from amongst others, the RREC, Aston Martin Owners Club, Bentley Drivers Club and Jaguar Drivers Club. Independent judges will pick a winner to be presented by Prince Michael of Kent who is their Patron. As well as the spectacular and very interesting cars invited to the main Concours there will be special displays of cars from the coachbuilder Zagato as well as from AMG. It is expected that the main body of our cars will be looking their best, but they will not be judged in any form of concours. (Our own concours d'etat will already have taken place at Sudeley Castle in July.)

We will also have special access for tours of the Royal Apartments and the Gardens and other areas. A members Marquee is being built to which we will have access and various arrangements are available for lunch and coffee including a high quality picnic provided by the organisers on the lawns. You can also of course take your own picnic.

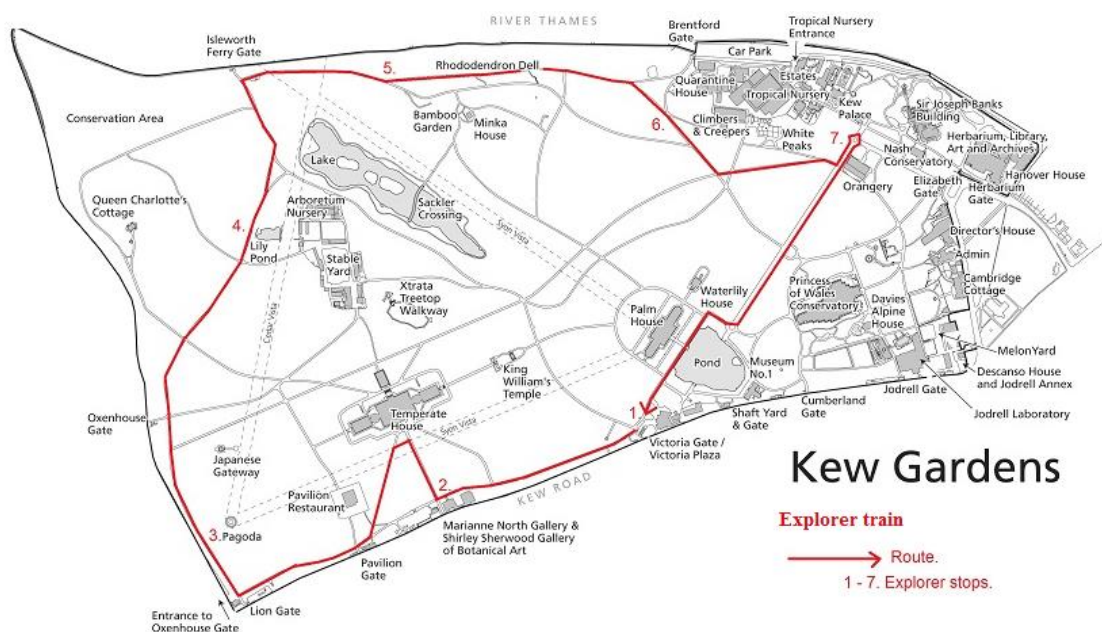
We have been invited for Friday, the best of the three days, as it avoids the crowds attending on Saturday and Sunday when the display is open to the public.

As we need to be in position by 09.30 am and we do not leave until 5.30 pm I have booked 20 rooms at Warren House, a grade II listed, late Victorian house on a private estate near Kingston On Thames which is approximately half an hour from Hampton Court.



The rooms are currently booked for Thursday night, with a smaller number booked for Friday night, as many of you may not wish to set off for home rather late on holiday Friday night when the traffic out of London is at its worst.

On Saturday Richmond Park and the fabulous Royal Botanic Gardens at Kew are just to the north of the Hotel. The difficulty at Kew is that parking is very restricted, but they would love us to come and we can make finalise arrangements, once I know how many wish to visit. One way to see a lot of Kew fairly quickly is to hop on their explorer train which takes you to all the main attractions
