Magnificent Yorkshire – God's Own County

Sunday 5th August – Thursday 9th August 2018



With its breath-taking landscape of Dales and Moors, the historic city of York with its famous Minster and the beautiful Spa town of Harrogate, Yorkshire is rightfully known as God's Own County. Rich in history and geographical diversity, this 20-Ghost Club Tour aims to give participants a real flavour of this beautiful, unspoilt part of England.

The tour will take you out to the Moors in the East and through the Dales in the West, it will incorporate visits to private car collections and to one of the country's most impressive Stately Homes, Castle Howard. In the evenings your senses will be filled with music and flowers as you attend the International Gilbert and Sullivan Festival in Harrogate and spend an evening at a Royal Horticultural Society Garden.



HARROGATE:

The Tour begins on **Sunday 5**th **August** in Harrogate where we arrive at Rudding Park Hotel and Spa in time for dinner. Rudding Park is one of Yorkshire's finest hotels with a new state of the art Spa. Set in stunning grounds just outside Harrogate, this will be our base for the week.

On **Monday 6th August** we leave for the North York Moors. This National Park has been designated An Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and boasts one of the largest expanses of heather moorland in the United Kingdom. Our tour will take you back in time along



deserted roads and stunning views to our destination: Castle Howard. Built more than 300 years ago, it is regarded as one of the country's great houses. It is a perfect example of English Baroque architecture and became iconic due to its role in the TV series and later film adaptation of *Brideshead Revisited*. In the evening we

return to Harrogate to enjoy dinner at of Betty's of Harrogate at the Royal Horticultural Gardens, Harlow Carr. The total tour distance will be approximately 120 kms.

On **Tuesday 7th August** we take a short drive to Yorkshire's most impressive private collections of early cars. The Ward Brothers Collection has the largest number of antique

and veteran vehicles in England. From trikes to tractors, their passion is overwhelming. We then tour the Yorkshire Dales with its valleys and peaks, rivers and waterfalls. There will be plenty of opportunities to stop for cup of tea or a pint of ale and visit the National Park Centre. That evening Dr Terry Bramall and his wife Liz will welcome you to a dinner at their Harrogate museum housing some of the world's most important and beautiful cars. Total Tour Distance is 130kms.



We start early on **Wednesday 8th August** and drive to York arriving at the National Railway Museum for coffee. Home of the Flying Scotsman, the Museum houses early locomotives and tells the story of our love affair with steam. There will then be plenty of time to visit York with its medieval alley ways and Roman Wall.



It would be hard to visit York and not take time to see the magnificent Minster. Dating back to 1230, it is the second largest Gothic Cathedral in Europe and centre of the Church of England in the North. The Minster has often played an important role in great national affairs - not least during the turbulent years of the Civil War.

Our late lunch stop will be at The Punch Bowl Inn at Marton-cum-Grafton, dating back to the 16th century it still retains its *old world* charm and cosy character. The inn displays a wealth of beams & characterful open fires.

We then return to Harrogate for the finale of the tour — a champagne reception and evening of Gilbert and Sullivan, "The Gondoliers", at the Royal Hall performed by the National Gilbert



and Sullivan Opera Company. Total Tour Distance is 100 kms.

On **Thursday 9th August** we depart after Breakfast......or if you can, extend your stay and enjoy the Spa. As they say in Yorkshire .'Eee by gum that were greet! Let the White Rose of Yorkshire live for ever....
