SOUTHERN IRELAND with the IRISH GEORGIAN SOCIETY 15th to 19th MAY 2015

Committee member John Redmill [who is also Chairman of the Irish Georgian Society's London Chapter], assisted by Jimmy Valentine, is arranging the 36th Annual Joint Tour of the two societies; this year, the tour will visit many of the wonderful country houses of Counties Waterford and Cork, in Southern Ireland. This area has always been wealthy, being some of the best agricultural land of the whole country, and in the 18th and early 19th centuries many country houses were built along the banks of the river Blackwater, the 'Irish Rhine'.

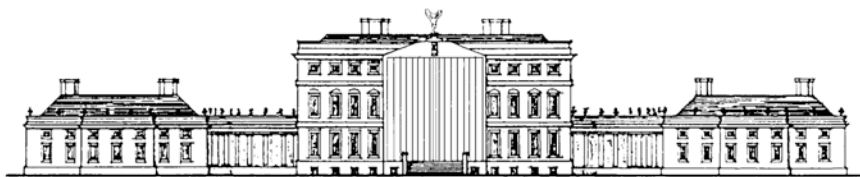
We will visit both smaller manor houses that are not open to the public and a selection of publicly open properties that most members will not have visited before. The full programme is currently being organised but, of the great houses, we plan to see Tourin, Cappoquin, Castlemartyr, Fota, Curraghmore, Kilshannig, Riverstown, and several others. We are also intending to visit at least one private collection of pre-War Rolls-Royces, and have a spectacular drive through the Knockmealdown Mountains. The hospitality of the Irish is legendary, as will be remembered from the 2008 and 2014 visits to the Dublin area and Northern Ireland. This itinerary is subject to change as details are finalised.



The tour will be based at The Park Hotel, Dungarvan, on the Waterford coast; the hotel is situated on the edge of the town, with a secluded car park. The tour is slightly longer than normal in view of the extra journey there, so will start with lunch on Friday 15th May and end after lunch on Tuesday 19th May. Please therefore arrange to arrive in good time for lunch, at a venue to be arranged, on Friday. The cost of travelling to and from Ireland is NOT included in the cost of the tour, and is the responsibility of members.

The cost will be ST£1,100.00 for two people sharing, or ST£600.00 for single occupancy and will include B & B for the nights of Friday 15th, Saturday 16th, Sunday 17th & Monday 18th May, lunch each day, dinner on Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Monday evenings, drinks at some meals, transport on one evening to avoid using the cars at night, and house entrance fees. The hotel is also happy to provide B&B for the night of Thursday 14th, so please indicate if you require this.

If you wish to come on the tour, please complete the attached application form and return it to Jimmy Valentine, 1 Hobury Street, LONDON SW10 0JD, with your cheque payable to the Irish Georgian Society London Chapter as soon as possible. If the tour is oversubscribed, priority will be given to those who were unable to come on last year's tour.
